

MEMO: 10-MINUTE EASTER MESSAGE (WITH BIBLICAL INSERT)

Date: 4 April 2026

Easter is truly—truly—world-changing.
History-changing.
Life-changing.

Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, has risen from the dead.

This is not just a moment in history.
This is the foundation of our faith.
This is the reason we have hope.
This is the reason we have life.

Today, churches around the world are filled.
