- 5) The female 18-29 Armenian population in Greater Boston is estimated by applying the same share of females aged 18-29 in Greater Boston's total population to the estimated total Armenian population. This assumes the Armenian community's age and sex distribution matches that of Greater Boston as a whole.
- 6) Greater Boston is defined as all ZIP codes within a 40-minute drive of the six Armenian churches in the Boston area.

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Only **1% - 3%** of the Greater Boston Armenian community is **"Faithful"** as defined;
the difference between 99% and 97% NOT attending is insignificant and serves as a distraction
